

Lagos State Land Use Charge Law 2020

Topic	Description		
Purpose	A legislation for property and land in Lagos State.		
Wider scope	Profit-oriented libraries, cemeteries, and burial grounds are no longer exempt from Land Use Charge.		
Persons exempt	Property owned and occupied by a pensioner is exempt from paying LUC. Pensioner now includes all retirees from private institutions in the state.		
Incentive	- COVID-19 incentive of 10% as well as a discount of 15% for early payment before the due date. Owners of - Vacant properties: 10% - Open empty land: 20%

Lesser penalty	Reduction in the penalty for late payment as follows: 45-75 days from 25% to 10%; 75-105 days from 50% to 20%; and 105-135 days from 100% to 50%.		
Lower fine	Inciting a person to refuse to pay LUC, obstruction of officials, and damage to property identification cards: NGN100,000 (Old: NGN250,000)		
Lesser fine	Reduction in the penalty for late payment as follows: 45-75 days from 25% to 10%; 75-105 days from 50% to 20%; and 105-135 days from 100% to 50%.		
Other clauses	Right of enforcement: Number of default notices is 2 (Old: 3). Right to select an agent: The Commissioner can appoint any person to collect LUC.
