INDUSTRIAL INSPECTORATE REGULATIONS, 2022

[7th Day of November, 2022]

Commencement.

Objective.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 10 of the Industrial Inspectorate Act, and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Otunba Richard Adeniyi Adebayo the Honourable Minister of Industry, Trade and Investment, hereby make the following Regulations—

PART I—OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE OF APPLICATION

1. The objective of these Regulations is to provide a regulatory framework for the collection of fees for the issuance of certificate for the acceptance of the application for fixed asset.

2. These Regulations shall apply to a proposed new and existing Application undertaking.

PART II—APPLICATION FOR ACCEPTANCE AND COLLECTION OF CERTIFICATES FEES

3. Application fee for issuance of certificate of acceptance for fixed asset shall be N20,000.00, per financial year or such sum as may be fixed by Regulation from time to time.

Application fee for issuance of certificate of acceptance.

4. Collection of certificate of acceptance fee shall be paid per certificate with ad valorem value as follows —
